

Clearfield corn provides additional herbicide option

Clearfield corn hybrids are tolerant to Lightning herbicide, promoting clean fields and excellent yields. Lightning provides extensive weed-control benefits, including:

- Premier grass control with excellent broadleaf activity
- Contact control PLUS residual control for early and season-long control and maximum yields
- Strong activity on woolly cupgrass
- Tank-mix options with any broadleaf product for waterhemp and ragweed control
- Broad-spectrum control of more than 50 grasses and broadleaf weeds
- No yield drag on Clearfield hybrids as verified by HYTEST SEEDS conversion tests

Clearfield corn hybrids, formerly known as IMI-Corn, contain a specific gene that imparts a high level of tolerance to Lightning herbicide. This specific gene in Clearfield hybrids prevents binding of the herbicide to its site of activity. Hybrids with this gene have exhibited excellent tolerance, even at several times the normal Lightning rate.

Plus, organophosphate insecticides can be used with IMI-tolerant corn and Lightning. There have been no instances of crop injury due to the interaction of Lightning with Counter CR.
